First: I hereby revoke, annul and make void that portion of the Second Section of my said Will, wherein I gave and bequeathed all my medical books to the Medical Library of Atlantic City, and I give and bequeath all my said medical books to my wife Sabina Barchi Malatesta to be disposed of by her in such way and manner as she may think best or to be presented by her to the Library of the Jefferson Medical College, in the City of Philadelphia,

SECOND: I will and direct that the following inscription to wit:

shall be placed upon the Chapel to be erected in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (c) of the Third Section of my said will.

Third: I hereby revoke, annul, and make void the entire paragraph (g) of the Third Section of my said will, and in place thereof I will and direct that at the decease of my wife, after all the directions concerning the capital or principal of the Trust held for her use and benefit during her lifetime as provided in said Third Section of my said will, shall have been fully carried out, the balance if any of the principal or capital of said Trust so

held for the use and benefit of my wife during her lifetime, and also at the decease of Tillie Savaresi the principal or capital of the trust created for her benefit as provided in paragraph (f) of the Third Section of my said Will, shall be paid by the Trustees appointed by my said Will share and share alike unto Jessie De. Ferrari, Sibbie Cessa, Amelia Abbs A. J.M. and James C. Scotti, or unto the survivor or survivors of them if any thereof should be deceased at the death of my wife.

Fourth: I hereby ratify and confirm my said will in all respects other than as herein altered.
