Knowall Men By These Present, that I, Matthew Patton, of the City of Philadelphia, of the State of Pennsylvania being of sound mind, memory and understanding, and considering the uncertainty of Life do therefore make, publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following that is to say.
