

EIGHTH. I order and direct that my trustees aforesaid shall have the right to determine the amounts that may be required for the proper education and maintenance of my child, or my children, and to pay the same out for said

education and maintenance from the income of my estate without first obtaining an order of the Court.

NINTH. In the event of the death of my wife Viola M. McGurk during the infancy of my child, or children, then it is my wish, and I hereby direct the Guarantee Trust Company to place my child, or my children, under the care of my sister-in-law Anna F. Frichsen.

The provisions herein made for my wife Viola M. McGurk are made in lieu of dower.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, Michael McGurk, have hereunto set my hand and seal this seventeenth day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one.
