Know all Men by these Presents That Mrs. Frederick P. Nichterlein of the City of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, Kate Mc Donald and Edward F. Nichterlein, Atlantic City, N. J. held and firmly bound unto Theodore E. Nichterlein Administrator of the Estate of Edward H. Nichterlein deceased in the sum of nine hundred and thirty five Dollars and seventy six cents lawful money of the United States of America to be paid to the said Theodore E. Nichterlein Administrator aforesaid his certain attorney, executors, administrators or assigns to which payment well and truly to be made we do bind and oblig ourselves our heirs, executors, administrators and assigns and each and every of them, firmly by these Presents sealed with our seals Dated the first day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and five (1905) Whereas the said Frederick P. Nichterlein, Kate Mc Donald and Edward F. Nichterlein have received from Theodore E. Nichterlein Administrator aforesaid each one hundred and fifty five <sup>9</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Dollars being their distributive share of the personal estate of the said Edward H. Nichterlein deceased. The Condition of this Obligation is such, That if any part, or the whole of the said distributive share shall at any time after the payment thereof to the said Frederick P. Nichterlein, Kate Mc Donald and Edward F. Nichterlein appears to be wanting to discharge any debt or debts truly owing by the said intestate shall be hereafter sued for and recovered or otherwise duly made which the said Theodore E. Nichterlein Administrator aforesaid shall not have other assets to pay, then and in such case, if the said Frederick P. Nichterlein, Kate Mc Donald and Edward F. Nichterlein shall and do return the said sum necessary to discharge and pay said debt or debts or such part thereof as may be necessary for the payment of said debt or debts, or the payment of a proportional part of said debt or debts and the costs of suit and charges by reason of such debt or debts out of the part and share so as aforesaid received by them then this obligation shall be void and of none effect, or else shall be and remain in full force and virtue.
