Munch Executors thereof.

Now the condition of this obligation is such that if any debt or debts truly owing by the said John M. Munch, aforesaid, shall be hereafter sued for and recovered or otherwise duly made to appear, for which there shall be no other assets to pay, that then and in every such case, if the said Anna Munch shall refund and pay back to the said Anna Lilly and Edward F. Munch, Executors as aforesaid, her ratable part of said debt or debts, and of the costs of suit and charges by reason of such debt or debts out of the part of share so as aforesaid received by her thereby to enable said Executors to satisfy said debt or debts, then the above obligation to be void, or else to be and remain in full force and virtue.
