Sealed with our seals and dated the 26th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and nine. In condition of this obligation it is such that if the above bounden Enoch Ireland sub. Administrator c.t.a. of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of Ann Joanna Ireland, deceased do make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to the hands, possession or knowledge of the said Enoch Ireland or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for the said Enoch Ireland and the same so made, do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the registry of the Prerogative Court in the Secretary's office of this State, or into the Surrogate's office of the County of Atlantic at or before the expiration of three calendar months from the date of the above written obligation, and the same goods, chattels and credits and all other goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased at the time of her death which at any time after shall come into the hands or possession of the said Enoch Ireland or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for the said Enoch Ireland do well and truly administer according to law and the provisions of the said will, and further, do make or cause to be made a just and true account of his administration within twelve calendar months from the date of the above written obligation and all the rest and residue of the said goods, chattels and credits which shall be found remaining upon the account of the said administration, the same being first examined and allowed by the Judge of the Orphans Court of the said County of Atlantic or other competent authority, shall deliver and pay unto such person or persons respectively as shall or shall by law and the provisions of said will be entitled to receive the same, then the said obligation to be void and of no effect; or else to remain in full force and virtue.
