The condition of this obligation is such that if the above bounden William Silliman administrator of said and singular the goods, chattels and credits of Thomas Reading deceased do make a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to the hands, possession or knowledge of the said William Silliman, or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for the said William Silliman and the same so made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the registry of the Probate Court in the Secretary's office of this State, or into the Surrogate's office of the County of Atlantic, at or before the expiration of three calendar months from the date of the above written obligation, and the same goods, chattels and credits, and all other goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased at the time of her death which at any time after shall come into the hands or possession of the said William Silliman, or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for the said William Silliman do well and truly administer according to law; and further do within twelve calendar months from the date of the above written obligation and all the rest and residue of the said goods, chattels and credits which shall be found remaining upon the account of the said administration, the same being first examined and allowed by the Judge of the Orphans Court of the County, or other competent authority, shall deliver and pay unto such person or persons respectively as is, are or shall by law be entitled to receive of the same; and if it shall hereafter appear that any part will or testament was made by the said deceased, and the executor or executors therein named, or any other person or persons, do exhibit the same into the said Probate Court or the Surrogate's office of the County of Atlantic, making a request to have it allowed and approved, in the said William Silliman binding himself to respect such testament being first had and made, the said Court, then the above obligation to be void and of no effect or else to remain in full force and vir
