Atlantic County Orphans Court.
In the matter of the Estate of Harry B. Bonner, deceased.

The order to show cause in this matter made on the second day of November, nineteen hundred and four, having been published according to law, and the Court having heard and examined the allegations and proofs, and it appearing on examination that the personal estate of the said Harry B. Bonner, deceased, is not sufficient to pay his debts, and that Lora B. Bonner, administratrix, has applied all the personal estate that has come to her hands to the payment of said debts, and that there is a deficiency amounting to the sum of two thousand six hundred ninety-nine dollars and ninety-four cents (\$2,699.94). It is thereupon, on this eighteenth day of January nineteen hundred and five, ordered that the said Lora B. Bonner, administratrix as aforesaid, sell the following tracts of land whereof the said Harry B. Bonner died seized, to wit: 1. All that certain tract or parcel of land situate in the township of Alloway, in the county of Atlantic and state of New Jersey, lying on the east side of the Main Shore Road leading from Absecon Village to Smithville, bounded as follows: Beginning at a peg or point for a corner standing in the east line of the Shore Road aforesaid and where the center line of the Meadow Road or lane intersects, and beginning corner of tract of land James Leeds and wife by deed dated July 17th, A. D. 1865 conveyed unto Charles Hammel, and corner to land of Charles Menzel, and runs thence (1) in the division line between lands of Hammel and Menzel and in the center line of said Meadow Road or lane south fifty-two degrees east, ten and six hundredths chains to a corner in said road, and where a fence intersects the fence on the north side of the Meadow Road aforesaid, thence (2) binding in said cross fence north twenty-eight degrees east, three and seventy-eight hundredths chains more or less to a corner to Isaac Bonner's land and Hammel's land, thence (3) binding in the division line between Bonner and Hammel north sixty degrees west, seven and seventy-five hundredths chains to the east line of Shore Road and corner of Bonner's and Hammel's land, thence (4) in the east line of Shore Road south fifty-six degrees and forty-five minutes west, four and sixty-eight hundredths chains more or less, to the beginning, containing four acres more or less. The grantor reserving the use of the Meadow Road or lane from Shore Road to his other land for carting and passing to and from the said other land and fields. 2.
