

improper charges in said account, they will therefore be stricken from the account and disallowed the accountant.

Items number 1 and 2 in the accountants account are allowed the exception being overruled.

Item 6 will be corrected so as to disallow two hundred and thirty-seven dollars for funeral bill; one hundred and seventy-eight dollars and seventy-five cents, Babely & Company's bill, seven dollars for board; sixty-five dollars for ticket, fifteen dollars for sleeping-car and an item of nine dollars and ninety cents by of Surrogate's bill; after making the above deduction from said items, then the balance will be allowed.

Items number 11 and 12 in the accountants account will be stricken therefrom and disallowed. Item number 20 is allowed.

Items numbers 32, 37, and 53 will be stricken from the account.

Items numbers 62, 64, 92, 106, 138, 127, 140, 141, 143, 154, 155, 163, 165, 166, 168, 169, 170, 171, 172, 173, 174, 175, 176, 177, 178, 179, 180, 181, 182, 184, 185, 186, 189, 192, and 130 are disallowed and will be stricken from the account.

Item 187 will be allowed in part to wit: there will be deducted from said item, sum of five dollars and sixty-three cents, the balance of said item will be allowed. Item 188 will be allowed for one-half the amount, the other half will be stricken from the account.

The Surrogate is directed to restate the account of Frederick A. Van Dyke the subject of exceptions in accordance with the views herein set forth and to report to this Court the amount then shown to be due the present administrator from the said Frederick A. Van Dyke. Upon this being done, I will sign an order directing the said Frederick A. Van Dyke to turn over the balance so found due to the present administrator within ten days from date of service of same upon him or his counsel, and such further order as is necessary or requisite in the premises. This order or decree to be signed upon five days notice to the said Frederick A. Van Dyke or his counsel, in order that he may appear and object to the audit of the Surrogate.
