Parents Release.

Whereas The undersigned being the mother of a child named Maud F.H. Campbell born, February 17, 1905 and being desirous that said child should come under the care of the New Jersey Children's Home Society; and Whereas, The New Jersey Children's Home Society is willing to receive and provide for said child a Christian Home, where said child will be loved, trained and educated, so as to be fitted for the requirements of life:

Now, Therefore, Elizabeth Campbell the undersigned, does hereby surrender said child to the New Jersey Children's Home Society, and does relinquish all right and claim to said child, and does undertake and promise not to interfere in the management of said child in any respect whatsoever, or to visit said child without the consent in writing of the Superintendent of the said New Jersey Children's Home Society, or to ask or to receive any consideration for the services of said child, or to take said child from, or to induce said child to leave the family where said child may be placed by the said New Jersey Children's Home Society.

The undersigned does hereby further consent that the said child may be adopted under and by virtue of the act of the Legislature entitled "An Act Concerning Minors, Their Adoption, Custody and Maintenance" (Revision of 1902), approved April 2, 1902, by such person or persons as may be approved by the said New Jersey Children's Home Society, and by the State Superintendent of said Society, without further notice to the undersigned. The undersigned does hereby further declare that it is the intent and purpose of this instrument that it should be accepted by any court in the State of New Jersey, having authority under the aforesaid act and its supplement to make decrees of adoption, as her consent required to be given by the aforesaid act. And the undersigned does hereby expressly authorize such court to accept this instrument as such consent.

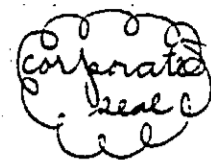

Lamb, of the City of Trenton, County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, of full age, being duly sworn according to law deposes and says that he is the Superintendent of the New Jersey Children's Home Society, an incorporated body in this State, whose business it is to find homes for needy and dependent children.

That the child, Maud Fernick Hudson Campbell, now in the care and custody of Harry S. Parsons and Edith Parsons, his wife, in the County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey, came into the possession of the said Society under the following circumstances: That the said child has no legal father, that the mother of said child, being wholly unable to care properly for said child, did on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February, 1906, of her own voluntary act and will surrender said child to the said Society, by executing in due form the parents release which is herewith enclosed, and contains the mother's full consent to the adoption of said child by the parties to the petition accompanying this instrument, as provided for in an Act of the Legislature entitled "An Act Concerning Minors, Their Adoption, Custody and Maintenance" (Revision of 1902) approved April 2, 1902.
