Decree of Distribution.

The account of J. Leonard Baier, administrator of the Estate of George Leonard Baier, deceased, having been duly audited and stated by the surrogate, and allowed in this Court, and it appearing by the said account that the sum of one hundred dollars and fifty-two cents remains for payment of debts, funeral charges and just expenses and it having been approved to the satisfaction of the Court that the said George Leonard Baier left his wife, Louisa Baier, now Louisa Will (her name by recent marriage) his mother, Kate Bates, and his sister, Anna Pauline Baier, him surviving as his only next of kin.

It is therefore on this Twenty-fifth day of March, nineteen hundred and seven, ordered, adjudged, and decreed that the aforesaid sum be distributed and paid to the above said widow and next of kin of the said George Leonard Baier as follows, To Wit:

- 1/2 part thereof amounting to the sum of \$50.26 to said Louisa Baier, now Louisa Will the widow of said George Leonard Baier.
- 1/4 part thereof amounting to the sum of \$25.13 to said Kate Bates.
- 1/4 part thereof amounting to the sum of \$25.13 to said Anna Pauline Baier.

Order Appointing Administrator Pendente Lite.

This matter coming on to be heard on petition of Nancy C. Enafe for the appointment of an administrator pendente lite, in the presence of S. Spencer Simpson, Proctor for said petitioner, and Harry Schneider, Proctor for proponent, and G. E. Cole, of counsel with the said Proctor for proponent, suggesting the appointment of said Harry Schneider as administrator pendente lite; and the Court having inquired of the Proctor for said petitioner if he had any objection to offer to the appointment of said Harry Schneider and having said that he had no objection to offer and that the appointment would be satisfactory to him, and no good reason appearing to the contrary.

It is, on this Twenty-ninth day of March, 1907, ordered, that Harry Schneider be, and he is hereby appointed administrator pendente lite, with the well annexed, of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of Daniel F. Hayden, deceased, with authority to administer the same agreeably to the statute in such case made and provided, until the final disposition of the appeal from the final probate of the last will and testament of said Hayden, deceased; and It is further ordered, that said administrator enter into bond with sufficient security in the sum of fifty thousand dollars.
