In the matter of the estate of Mary Bell Lee, deceased } Order

It appearing that by an order of the Surrogate of the County of Atlantic, made on the nineteenth day of January nineteen hundred and eight, Edwin C. Lee, administrator of the estate of Mary Bell Lee, deceased, was directed to give public notice to the creditors of the said estate to bring in their debts, demands, and claims against the said estate under oath within six months from the date of said order, and the said Edwin C. Lee having by his petition filed herein, represented that according to the state of his knowledge and belief, the real and personal estate of the aforesaid decedent is insufficient to pay her debts and pray that the aforesaid estate might be decreed insolvent.

It is therefore on this first day of February nineteen hundred and nine ordered that the twenty first day of April nineteen hundred and nine be and the same is hereby fixed for the said administrator to make report to this Court of the several claims and demands which may be exhibited against said estate, and to exhibit therewith under oath an account of the same, goods and chattels, rights and credits of the said decedent, which have come to his knowledge, hands or possession, and also an inventory of the real estate of said decedent which has come to his knowledge, and the value thereof as near as may be, and on the hearing of the application that said estate be decreed insolvent and it is further ordered that the said Edwin C. Lee give due notice according to the statute in such case made and provided of his intentions to make such report and applications.

In the matter of the estate of Fredericka Schneider } Order for distribution
deceased

The final account of Valentine P. Hoffmann executor of the estate of Fredericka Schneider, deceased, having been duly filed exhibiting a balance of one thousand five hundred and sixteen dollars and nine cents of the said estate in his hands up to the date of filing the same, and such account having been duly allowed by this Court, and it appearing that the said Fredericka Schneider, deceased, was and by her last Will directed, that all of the rest, and residue, and remainder of her said estate, after payment of her debts, and the expenses of settlement of her estate should be divided, as follows, that is to say; That a certain mortgage for the sum of eight hundred dollars, made by Conrad Kuchman should be given to her nephew Henry F. Heber, his heirs, or assigns, that the sum of twenty five dollars each should be given to Fritz Cange and Henry Cange, their heirs, and assigns, that the sum of fifty dollars be given to St. Johns ^{German} Reform Church of Egg Harbor City, to be applied towards paying expenses for building a parsonage, and further that after the making of the above payments, the rest, residue and remainder then in the hands of the executor should be equally divided between her said nephew Henry F. Heber and the nephew of her deceased husband a certain Fritz Leiner, or to their respective heirs, or assigns, and it appearing to the Court that these remains, after all debts and expenses have been allowed and deducted the sum of one thousand five hundred and sixteen dollars and nine cents in the hands of the said Valentine P. Hoffmann executor, as aforesaid for distribution in accordance with the terms of said Will; and it further appearing, that due notice of this application has been given to all parties in interest.

It is on this 26th day of January 1909 ordered, that the aforesaid sum be distributed and paid in accordance with the directions and provisions of the said last Will of the said Fredericka Schneider, deceased, as follows to wit: Fifty dollars to St. Johns German Reform Church, twenty five dollars to Fritz Cange, twenty five dollars to Henry Cange one mortgage, assenting to eight hundred dollars, to Henry F. Heber, and the balance of five hundred and sixteen dollars and nine cents, equally between Henry F. Heber and Fritz Leiner, or to their respective heirs, executors or assigns.
