Cluley, guardian of Charles Sinickson Dickerson, a minor, respectfully shows that he is a resident of the City and County of Philadelphia in the State of Pennsylvania, and that on the Twenty fourth day of February, nineteen hundred and thirteen, he was appointed by the Orphans' Court of the City and County of Philadelphia, guardian of the property of Charles Sinickson Dickerson, a minor, residing in the City and County of Philadelphia and State of Pennsylvania, as aforesaid.

Your petitioner further shows that the said Charles Sinickson Dickerson, minor as aforesaid, is entitled to personal property situated within the County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey, to wit: A distributive share in the estate of Charles E. Stevenson, deceased, who died intestate, and which estate is about to be settled by the final account of Rev. William W. Blatchford, administrator, now pending in the Orphans' Court in the said County of Atlantic:

ORDER.

It appearing from the petition of Andrew P. Cluley, filed herein, that the said petitioner resides in the City and County of Philadelphia, in the State of Pennsylvania, and that he is the Guardian duly appointed by the Orphans' Court of the said City and County of Philadelphia, of the person and property of Charles Sinickson Dickerson, a minor residing in the said City and County of Philadelphia and State of Pennsylvania. And it further appearing that the said Charles Sinickson Dickerson, minor, as aforesaid, is entitled to personal property situated within the County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey, to wit: a distributive share in the estate of Charles E. Stevenson, deceased, amounting to Twelve Hundred seven 92-100 Dollars now in the possession of Rev. William W. Blatchford, administrator of the said estate and proof being made to the satisfaction of the Court by certificate of the Orphans' Court of the City and County of Philadelphia in the State of Pennsylvania duly authenticated according to the Acts of Congress that the said Andrew P. Cluley, Guardian as aforesaid, has given adequate security as such Guardian in double the amount of the value of the aforesaid distributive share over and above the value of the property of such ward in the place of his residence.

And it further appearing that due notice of this application has been given to the said Rev. William W. Blatchford, Administrator as aforesaid, in whose custody the said distributive share is as aforesaid; and the Court having investigated the matter.

And it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that it is for the interest of the said Charles Sinickson Dickerson, ward as aforesaid, that said Guardian be permitted to remove the said distributive share to which the said ward is entitled as aforesaid from this State;

It is thereupon on this twenty-sixth day of December, nineteen hundred and thirteen ordered that the said Andrew P. Cluley, Guardian as aforesaid be and he is hereby authorized to demand, sue for, collect and receive the distributive share to which his said ward, Charles Sinickson Dickerson, is entitled as aforesaid, and remove the same to the place of residence of him and his ward, and it is further ordered that the delivery, transfer and payment of such distributive share by the said Rev. William W. Blatchford, administrator of Charles E. Stevenson, deceased, to the said Andrew P. Cluley Guardian of Charles Sinickson Dickerson shall be a legal discharge and acquittance for the same.
