; I was born in Messeri Italy
on the 24 day of June, anno
Domini 1884; I now reside at Hammonville N.J.
I emigrated to the United States of America from Messeri, Italy
on the vessel* Austria; my last
foreign residence was Italy

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign
prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Victor Emmanuel
King of Italy, of which I am now a citizen subject; I
arrived at the port of New York City, in the
State of New York on or about the 10 day
of May, anno Domini 1901; I am not an anarchist; I am not a
polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith
to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
