## DECLARATION OF INTENTION

I, Charles Romano, aged 27 years, occupation chef, do declare on oath that my personal description is: Color white, complexion light, height 5 feet 5 inches, weight 178 pounds, color of hair brown, color of eyes brown, other visible distinctive marks mustache.

I was born in Genoa, Italy, on the 14th day of Oct, anno Domini 1891; I now reside at 2216 Atlantic Ave Atlantic City, N.J. I emigrated to the United States of America from Genoa, Italy, on the vessel Aeneas; my last foreign residence was Genoa, Italy.

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Victor Emmanuel III King of Italy, of which I am now a citizen subject; I arrived at the port of New York City, in the State of New York, on or about the 14th day of Oct, anno Domini 1899; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
