## DECLARATION OF INTENTION

occupation farmer, do declare on oath that my personal  
description is: Color white, complexion fair, height 5 feet 6 inches,  
weight 128 pounds, color of hair brown, color of eyes brown

\_\_\_\_\_ ; I was born in Troppau Austria  
\_\_\_\_\_ on the 28 day of Dec, anno  
Domini 1886; I now reside at West Egg Harbor City N.J.  
I emigrated to the United States of America from Fiume Hungary  
on the vessel Slavonia; my last  
foreign residence was Troppau Austria

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign  
prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Francis Joseph Emperor  
of Austria and Apostolic King of Hungary of which I am now a citizen subject; I  
arrived at the port of New York City, in the  
State New York on or about the 14th day  
of May, anno Domini 1906; I am not an anarchist; I am not a  
polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith  
to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
