## DECLARATION OF INTENTION

(Invalid for all purposes seven years after the date hereof)

State of New Jersey, Atlantic County } In the Court  
of Atlantic Co.

I, Stanislas Migliaccio, aged 20 years, occupation laborer, do declare on oath that my personal description is: Color white, complexion dark, height 5 feet 2 inches, weight 125 pounds, color of hair black, color of eyes brown, other visible distinctive marks none.

I was born in Naples Italy, on the 10th day of Mar, anno Domini 1891; I now reside at Pleasantville NJ. I emigrated to the United States of America from Naples Italy on the vessel Arcora; my last foreign residence was Naples Italy.

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Victor Emmanuel King of Italy, of which I am now a citizen; I arrived at the port of Philadelphia, in the State of Pennsylvania on or about the 24th day of April, anno Domini 1909; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
