I was born in Delia Italy on the 2nd day of August, anno Domini 1861; I now reside at 32 N. Miss Ave Atlantic City, N.J.

I emigrated to the United States of America from Calermot Italy on the vessel S. Guglielmo; my last foreign residence was Delia Italy.

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Victor Emmanuel 3rd King of Italy, of whom I am now a subject;

I arrived at the port of New York City, in the State of New York, on or about the 8th day of June, anno Domini 1913; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
