DECLARATION OF INTENTION

(Invalid for all purposes seven years after the date hereof)

I, Joe Kaplan, aged 38 years, occupation tailor, do declare on oath that my personal description is: Color white, complexion dark, height 5 feet 5 inches, weight 120 pounds, color of hair black, color of eyes brown, other visible distinctive marks none.

I was born in Kovono Russia on the 13th day of July, anno Domini 1886; I now reside at 2001 Arctic Ave. Atlantic City, New Jersey (Give number, street, city or town, and State.)

I emigrated to the United States of America from Liverpool England on the vessel Lutania; my last foreign residence was Kovono Russia (If the alien arrived otherwise than by vessel, the character of conveyance or name of transportation company should be given.)

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Nicholas and Empress of all the Russias, of whom I am now a subject; I arrived at the port of New York City, in the State of New York, on or about the 15th day of November, anno Domini 1907; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:

ATLANTIC COUNTY COURT OF COMMON PLEAS.

In the matter of the Declaration of Intention of Joseph Piacentini. **ORDER.**

IT APPEARING to the Court that Joseph Piacentini did on the 37th day of April 1915, make his declaration of intention as number 1095 to become a citizen of the United States in the Common Pleas Court of Atlantic County, State of New Jersey. And at the time declared he was born in Alife, Italy, on the 10th day of September, 1886, and it further appearing that since so declaring his intention the said Joseph Piacentini has discovered in some of his old papers, his original army certificate which is signed by the Secretary of War for the Government of Italy, and approved by the Attorney of Military matters under military seal, dated September 27, 1906 and said military certificate sets forth that the said Joseph Piacentini was born on September 8, 1885.

AND THE COURT being satisfied that the correct date of birth of the said Joseph Piacentini is September 8, 1885. It is on this 25th day of May, A.D. 1917 ORDERED that the said declaration of Intention of the said Joseph Piacentini heretofore filed in the said Common Pleas Court of Atlantic County, State of New Jersey on the 37th day of April, 1915 being Number 1095 be amended to read "I was born in Alife, Italy, on the 8th day of September, Anno Domini, 1885"; instead of the wording "I was born in Alife, Italy on the 10th day of September, Anno Domini, 1886."
