I was born in Halifax, England on the 17th day of March, anno Domini 1879; I now reside at 903 Atlantic Ave Atlantic City, New Jersey (Give number, street, city or town, and State.)

I emigrated to the United States of America from Liverpool, England on the vessel Haverford; my last foreign residence was Halifax, England.

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to George 5th King of Great Britain and Ireland, of whom I am now a subject; I arrived at the port of New York City, in the State of New York, on or about the 26th day of September, anno Domini 1900; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:

I emigrated to the United States of America from Naples, Italy on the vessel Credic; my last foreign residence was Caserta, Lanza.

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Victor Emmanuel 3rd King of Italy, of whom I am now a subject; I arrived at the port of Boston, in the State of Mass, on or about the 11th day of May, anno Domini 1913; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
