
Enclosed herewith kindly find my copy of
Declaration of Intention written and filed at your Office
on January 23, 1917.

Having reached my twenty-first birthday, I am desirous to become a citizen of the United States of America. I note it is necessary for me to secure a Landing Certificate, however, I have discovered that at the time I made my Declaration of Intention I stated that the year of my arrival in the United States was 1907. This was an error, on my part, it should be 1908. As I was ten years old on my arrival I find that 1908 should be the correct date, altho I was under the impression that it was 1907 at the time.

I should greatly appreciate your kind assistance in the matter if you will make the change: viz. 1908 instead of 1907, as the date of my arrival. Thus eliminate confusion when I send same to Washington for my Landing Certificate. Will you also send me Form used for this purpose?
