I, Abraham Pritz, aged 39 years, occupation merchant, do declare on oath that my personal description is: Color white, complexion light, height 5 feet 7 inches, weight 145 pounds, color of hair light, color of eyes brown, other visible distinctive marks none

I was born in Kiev, Russia on the 25th day of August, anno Domini 1877; I now reside at 2401 Pacific Ave Atlantic City, New Jersey

I emigrated to the United States of America from Hamburg, Germany on the vessel Gauff Maldersee; my last foreign residence was Kiev, Russia

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to the Present Government of Russia, of whom I am now a subject;

I arrived at the port of New York City, in the State of New York, on or about the 16th day of August, anno Domini 1904; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:

SO HELP ME GOD.
