I, Melligan Edward Byrne, aged 41 years, occupation foreman, do declare on oath that my personal description is: Color white, complexion dark, height 5 feet 8 inches, weight 170 pounds, color of hair brown, color of eyes grey, other visible distinctive marks none

I was born in County Cork Ireland on the 9th day of July, anno Domini 1876; I now reside at 214 N. Florida Ave Atlantic City New Jersey

I emigrated to the United States of America from Queenstown Ireland on the vessel New England; my last foreign residence was County Cork Ireland; I am un married; the name of my wife is Mary M.; she was born at County Cork Ireland and now resides at Atlantic City N.J.

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to George 5th King of Great Britain and Ireland, of whom I am now a subject;

I arrived at the port of Boston, in the State of Mass., on or about the 3rd day of June, anno Domini 1913; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein: SO HELP ME GOD.
