I, Peter La Rosa, aged 26 years, occupation Chauffeur, do declare on oath that my personal description is: Color White, complexion Dark, height 5 feet 4 inches, weight 125 pounds, color of hair Dark Brown, color of eyes Brown

I was born in Mibazza Italy on the 27th day of December, anno Domini 1893; I now reside at 17th Mississippi Avenue Atlantic City, N.J.

I emigrated to the United States of America from Messina Italy on the vessel Do not remember; my last foreign residence was Mibazza Italy; I am not married; the name of my last wife was Emma

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state or sovereignty, and particularly to Victor Emmanuel 3rd King of Italy, of whom I am now a subject;

I arrived at the port of New York City in the State of New York on or about the 19th day of August, anno Domini 1901; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein;
