occupation Laborer, do declare on oath that my personal  
description is: Color Red, complexion Light, height 5 feet 10 1/2 inches,  
weight 170 pounds, color of hair Brown, color of eyes Brown  
other visible distinctive marks None

I was born in Belville Canada  
on the 25th day of January, anno Domini 1884; I now reside  
at 619 Medit Ave Atlantic City N.J.  
(Give number, street, city or town, and State)

I emigrated to the United States of America from Toronto Canada  
on the vessel Grand Trunk R.R.; my last  
(If the alien arrives otherwise than by vessel, the character of conveyance or name of transportation company should be given.)  
foreign residence was Toronto Canada; I am 7 married; the name

of my wife is Mamie Palmer, she was born at Richmond Virginia
