I was born in Solunna, Italy
on the 21st day of February, anno Domini 1900, I now reside
at Edge Park City, N. J.
(Give number, street, city or town, and state)
I emigrated to the United States of America from Solunna, Italy
on the vessel Stanta Aleghieri
(If the alien arrives both by sea and by land, the character of conveyance and name of transportation company should be given)
my last
foreign residence was Solunna, Italy; I am not married; the name
of my wife is none
and now resides at none

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign
prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Victor Emmanuel
3rd King of Italy, of whom I am now a subject;
I arrived at the port of New York City in the
State of New York, on or about the 15th day
of July, anno Domini 1916; I am not an anarchist; I am not a
polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith
to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
SO HELP ME GOD
