I, Abraham Samuel Friedman, aged 36 years, occupation Merchant, do declare on oath that my personal description is: Color White, complexion Dark, height 5 feet 5 inches, weight 175 pounds, color of hair Black, color of eyes Brown, other visible distinctive marks None

I was born in Bersoff Russia on the 16th day of April, anno Domini 1883. I now reside at 2404 Fairmount Ave Atlantic City, N.J.

I emigrated to the United States of America from Rotterdam Holland on the vessel Stutterdams

foreign residence was Bersoff Russia; I am married; the name of my wife is Fella Friedman, she was born at New York City

and now resides at 2404 Fairmount Ave Atlantic City. It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Present Government of Russia

of whom I am now a subject; I arrived at the port of New York City

State of New York, on or about the 29th day of November, anno Domini 1905

I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein: SO HELP ME GOD.
