DECLARATION OF INTENTION

Invalid for all purposes seven years after the date hereof

In the Court of Common Pleas of Atlantic County, State of New Jersey. I, Khoren Najorian, known as Harry Khoren Najorian, aged 32 years, occupation Candy Manufacturer, declare on oath that my personal description is: Color White, complexion Dark, height 5 feet 5 inches, weight 160 pounds, color of hair Dark Brown, color of eyes Brown, other visible distinctive marks none. I was born in Malatia, Turkey on the 10th day of April, anno Domini 1887; I now reside at 1624 Pacific Ave Atlantic City, New Jersey. I emigrated to the United States of America from Patras, Greece on the vessel Mardian Medwayton; my last foreign residence was Malatia, Turkey; I am not married; the name of my wife is she was born at Malatia, Turkey.

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Mehemmed 6th Emperor of the Ottomans, of whom I am now a subject; I arrived at the port of New York City, in the State of New York, on or about the 4th day of October, anno Domini 1909; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein: SO HELP ME GOD.
