All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, of whatever kind and wheresoever situate, I give, devise and bequeath unto my niece, Elizabeth McCutcheon, in fee and absolutely.

I appoint my niece, Elizabeth McCutcheon and my nephew Samuel K. Harvey to be the Executors and Trustees of this my last will and testament and for the purposes of making distribution of my estate, or otherwise, I give unto them, and the survivor of them, full power and authority to sell any and all of my estate at public or private sale, at such times, at such prices and upon such terms as they may deem most advantageous, and to execute all deeds and other papers as may be necessary to vest a good title in the purchaser hereby relieving any and all purchasers from seeing to the application of the purchase money.
