### DIRECTIONS.

FOR MAKING MUSH with No. 1, GROUND COARSE—Mix four tablespoonful of the Wheat with a gill of cold water; rub into a smooth paste; then pour it into a pint of boiling water, stirring briskly; boil for 20 minutes. To be eaten with rich cream.

FOR PUDDINGS, &c., USE No. 2, GROUND FINE.—Mix a tablespoonful of the Food with a small quantity of cold water; rub to a smooth paste; add to one-half pint of boiling water, constantly stirring, and boil about 8 minutes over a moderate fire. Add milk and Sugar to taste. For bread, use as ordinary flour.

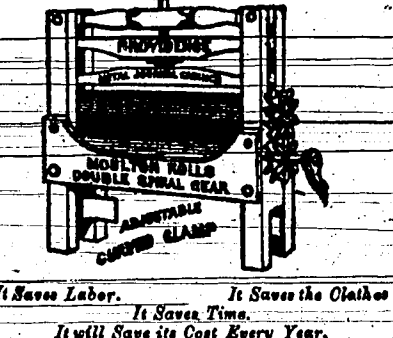
